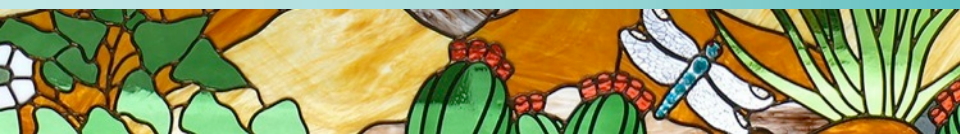

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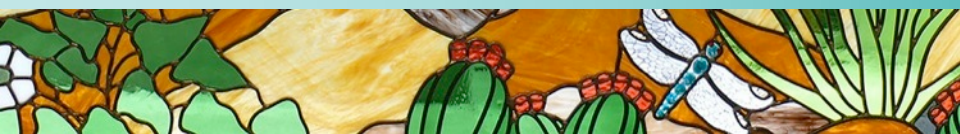


# Quality Care is Not Enough

  - Native Americans have highest rates

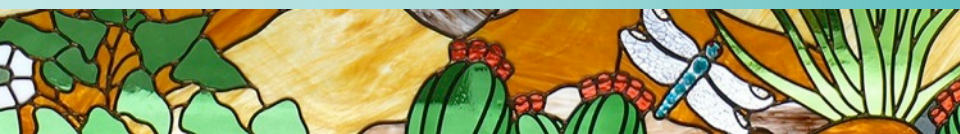

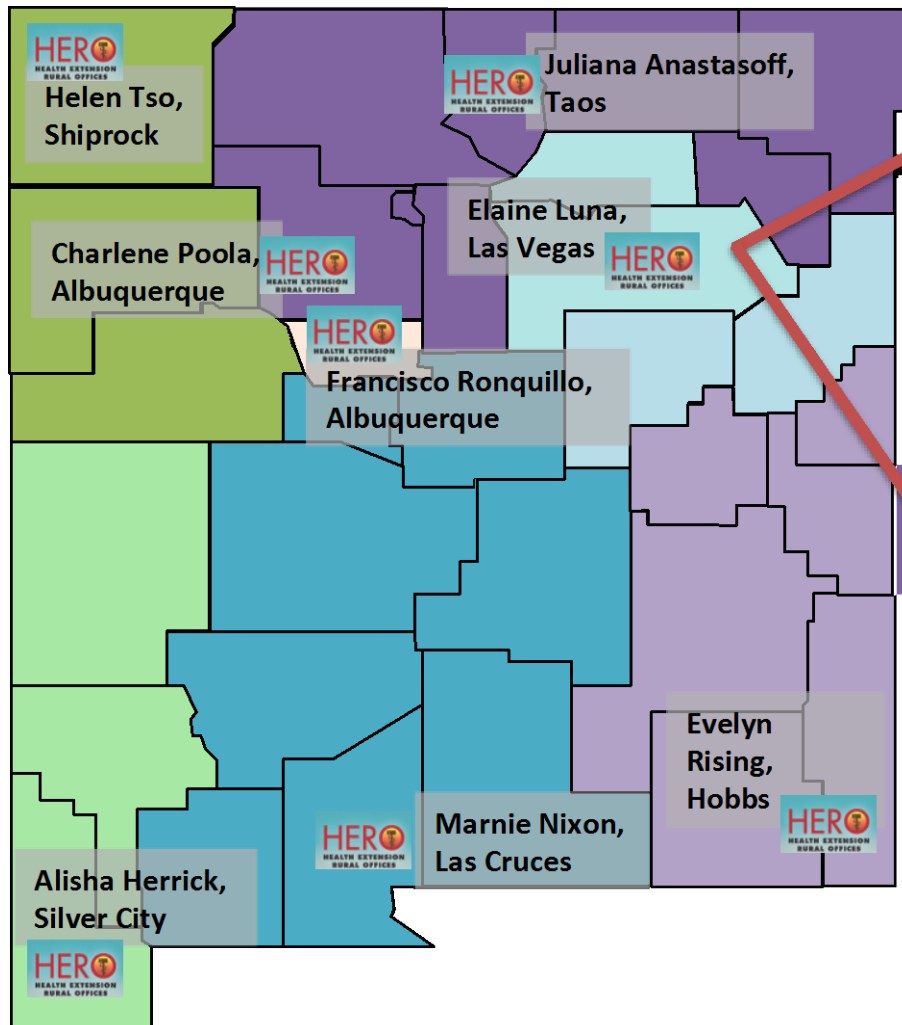

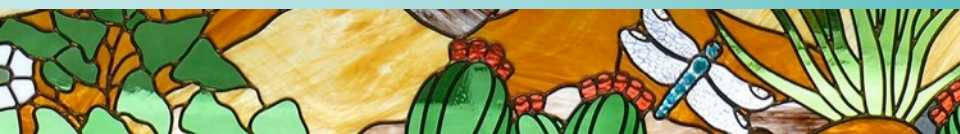

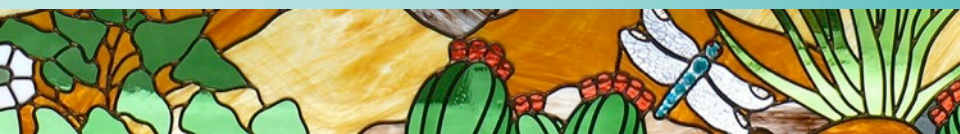
# Map of HEROs and their regions



## *Components of HERO Hub*









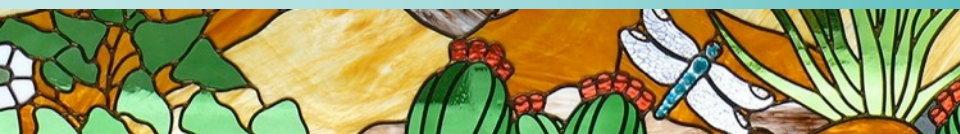
